### **Who are we?**

RSVP has over 20 years' experience of developing and managing projects with an intergenerational approach in Wales. We have a number of active intergenerational projects which are Wales-wide as well as intergenerational projects which have been developed to reflect local needs and priorities, like our Big Lottery funded 'Skills Swap' and 'Help 4 Carers' projects, our Heritage Lottery funded 'Celebrating History Together' and the volunteer led project 'Connecting Generations' funded by the Millennium Stadium Trust. Our aim is to achieve sustainability for all our projects, using our well established 'volunteer led, volunteer managed' model - which makes us particularly suited to working with community groups.
